- ✓ We anticipate arriving at Perranporth around lunchtime






























Kit list

- ✓ 2 pairs of outdoor shoes 1 that will almost certainly get wet; 1 pair that are sturdy enough for lots of walking!
- ✓ 2 towels
- ✓ Flip flops
- √ (cheap neoprene) Surf shoes are recommended
- √ Waterproof jacket lots of outdoor activities
- ✓ Sun cream and sun hat
- ✓ Swimming kit
- √ Warm clothing for evenings (including a coat)
- ✓ Limited storage space please pack lightly (one small-ish bag)
- ✓ Named water bottle for re-using throughout the week

- ✓ No phones staff have emergency numbers and contact school daily
- ✓ Daily updates will be made on the school's Facebook page
- ✓ All medicines (label/dosage/name) to Mrs French on departure day
